

# Barwon Park Mansion Winchelsea



Enjoy an informative guided tour of Barwon Park Mansion, a 42 room bluestone mansion and stables built for Thomas and Elizabeth Austin and their 11 children. Completed in 1869 this was the finest and most celebrated mansion house in western Victoria. In the manner of the wealthy country squire, Austin loved shooting and in 1859 he imported quails, pheasants, foxes and rabbits for that purpose. In the eyes of many he became responsible for Australia's substantial rabbit problems. His wife, founded the Austin Hospital in Melbourne.

Once your tour of Barwon Park Mansion is complete, board the coach for Winchelsea Shire Hall Tea Rooms for a delicious two course lunch.
