

Phillip Island, Vietnam Museum, Seal Rock



Take a trip only 90 minutes from Melbourne and visit Phillip Island. Experience coastal scenery and charming heritage on this wildlife island. Visit the National Vietnam Veterans Museum which is nationally recognized and dedicated to the preserving and displaying of photographs, memorabilia, vehicles and aircraft that detail the history of Australian involvement in the Vietnam War from 1962 to 1972.



Enjoy a delicious 2 course lunch at the Phillip Island RSL and then head for the far south western tip of Phillip Island "The Nobbies". Here boardwalks and lookout points offer spectacular coastal views and a chance to view Australia's largest colony of fur seals, located 1km offshore. Up to 16,000 seals gather at Seal Rocks, with the number peaking during breeding season from October to December.
